TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN (TK) PROGRAM

Only offered at our Canyon Branch

Our TK program is open to all children who turn 5 years old between September 2nd and February 2nd of the current school year. Proof of age must be provided upon enrollment. In partnership with the Laguna Beach Unified School District, we are now offering after school care for TKs with transportation from El Morro Elementary and Top of the World Elementary. Our TK program provides a great opportunity to continue enhancing your child's social emotional development and school readiness skills with a play-based approach. Our bilingual TK team all have educational backgrounds in Early Childhood Education and Child Development providing a high quality Club experience for our youngest members. Our TK program offers a variety of STEM, art, and play activities to help build their social and emotional skills, nurture their curiosity, and foster fine and gross motor skills in their own dedicated safe space with a low staff to student ratio. We use Brightwheel for secure parent sign-in and sign-out, share photos and videos with parents throughout the day, billing and easy communication with our TK team. A nutritious lunch meal is provided for TKs arriving from the Early Bird session from El Morro Elementary and Top of the World Elementary.

The Kinder Cove is complete with a variety of educational toys and materials to attract their differing interests, their own restrooms, cubbies, and play yard. Kinder Cove is a warm, fun, and imaginative space that allows them to be kids. We provide a structured environment while building routines to foster healthy development.

The Kinder Cove is a safe place where the little ones can thrive and voice their opinions knowing that they will be heard. In this space, they learn how to be respectful and kind to their peers and adults, as well as learning to try things on their own before asking for help. They learn that making mistakes are okay and a part of growing up. With the help of our trained Early Childhood team, Kinder Buddies learn to embrace their mistakes and uniqueness.


