Camp Overview

Welcome to nine weeks of fun, safe, educational, and recreational programs, outdoor experiences, and group activities. This full-day program promises participants will be active, learn new things, and make new friends. Camp also includes exciting field trips, special events, and theme days.

Canyon Branch features the Games Room, an Education and Technology Center, an Art Room, a Tween Loft, a Teen Center, Outdoor Playground, a "Chill Zone," a snack bar, a full-size Gym, and a dedicated space for kindergarteners.

Summer Programs

Kinder Cove

The Kinder Cove is a dedicated space complete with a courtyard, garden, chill zone, and private restrooms. The summer kinder program implements a wide range of activities in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), arts, sports, recreation, and more!

Elementary grades

Age groups rotate between the Games Room, Ed/Tech, Art Room, Gym, and Playground. Campers will play, learn, and grow collaboratively as they participate in our diverse and interactive Club experience.

Middle school

Members can socialize with friends, play their favorite games, and participate in the arts, sports, and STEM programs in their own Club space.

High School

High schoolers have a space of their own (grades 9th-12th).

Beach Tuesdays

Beachgoers will be shuttled to Diver's Cove for some fun in the sun. Remember to pack your child with a sack lunch as they will eat at the Club before departing.

- Parents pick-up at Diver's Cover no later than 5:00 p.m.
- Must be able to swim!
- Pack a water bottle, sandals to change into, sunscreen, extra snacks, and a towel.
- Recommended to wear a rash guard or swim shirt.
- Space is limited.

Pool Tuesdays

Swimmers will be shuttled to the Laguna Beach High School pool. Remember to pack your child with a sack lunch as they will eat at the Club before departing. Swimmers will walk back to the Club. Bring comfortable walking shoes!

- Space is limited.

Water Blast Tuesdays (6/18, 7/16, 8/13)



SUNSCREEN UTILIZATION PERMISSION

As the parent of the child, I give permission for staff to apply sunscreen of SPF 15 or higher to my child when he or she is engaging in outdoor activities. I understand that sunscreen may be applied to exposed skin, including but not limited to the face, tops of ears, nose, bare shoulders, arms, and legs.

I acknowledge that application alone will not prevent my child from sunburn and release from liability the staff of the Boys & Girls Club of Laguna Beach if sunburn is to occur.

I (we) the parent, parents or legal guardian of the child listed on this field trip/event permission slip, a minor, do hereby request that he/she should the need arise, do hereby authorize and consent to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis rendered under the general or special supervision of any member of the medical staff and emergency room staff licensed under the provisions of the Medicine Practice Act or dentist licensed under the provisions of the Dental Practice Act and on the staff of any acute general hospital holding a current license to operate a hospital from the state of California, Department of Health. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment or hospital care being required. This authorization is given to provide authority and power to render care which the physician, in the exercise of his/her best judgment may deem advisable. It is understood that effort shall be made to contact the legal guardian prior to rendering treatment to the patient, but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the guardian cannot be reached. I will not hold Boys & Girls Clubs of Laguna Beach liable for medical aid rendered.
